April Book Sale

The monthly book sale will be held in the Library auditorium on April 12th through the 14th. On Thursday, April 12th, from 1:00 to 3:00, members of the Friends will have an opportunity to select books before the sale is opened to the public from 3:00 - 6:00. The sale is also open to the public on Friday, April 13th, from 9:30 – 4:30, and on Saturday, April 14th, from 9:30 - 1:00.



The Friends Book Store adjacent to the auditorium will be open from 9:30 - 4:30 on Thursday and Friday and 9:30 - 1:00 on Saturday. In the store you will find more current copyright dates in both fiction and non-fiction than in the monthly sale books. You will also find a nice selection of children's books, large print books and specially priced table top books, as well as DVDs, CDs and puzzles.

If your membership has lapsed, you may renew at this time, or interested patrons may join for the first time (\$5 per person). All proceeds from the monthly book sale and the Friends Book Store support the library's programs and special needs.


